

## A Message To Doctors – Evaluating Your Priorities

We must learn to think outside the box. Unfortunately, that's something doctors are not encouraged to do in medical school. If they did, they would discover what I did many years ago. Most traditionally trained doctors (even those who graduated from some of the most prestigious institutions in the nation) all too often just go with the flow. Thus, they are not learning to become independent thinkers. Rather than questioning the benefit versus the risks of the drugs they prescribe daily, and wondering if there might possibly be a better solution, they just continue following their pharmaceutical rep's advice, and AMA-approved procedures. One problem doctors (M.D.s) are forced to deal with is, the risk of censorship by the AMA, from not adhering to AMA-approved procedures, which excludes most natural therapies.

Unfortunately, few doctors make the effort to discover what causes people to get diseases such as cancer and diabetes, or why many die from strokes and heart attacks. The truth is – they can normally be prevented, although not with the drugs they continue prescribing! They likely aren't aware that they have become pawns, (or basically legal drug dealers), as long as they remain in that box, both created and tightly controlled, by the pharmaceutical giants, and also supported by the FDA, and even the AMA.

For doctors, the path of least resistance, (and often even the most profitable approach), is to continue as usual, and ignore what's in the patient's best interest. If you're a doctor prescribing drugs daily, you might think long and hard as to why you devoted so many years, (along with a great deal of money), completing your M.D. If it was for the money, you should have chosen another profession, as people's lives are at stake, and they trust in your judgment! Their lives are in your hands – without a doubt, a tremendous responsibility. If your intentions are truly altruistic, you need to start thinking outside of the "pharmaceutical box" that you and many other doctors had been placed in, while in medical school, and learn how you can truly help your patients. If you are looking for job satisfaction, (and money is not your primary goal), I would suggest you start focusing on disease prevention, and even healing "supposedly incurable" diseases. Believe me – the resources are out there, and normally provided by Our Creator. A great number of valuable life-saving resources are continuing to be ignored.
